**RE: Town of Amherst to demolish 2 Industrial Park Dr.**

**AMHERST, Nova Scotia** – The Town of Amherst will be demolishing a building at 2 Industrial Park Dr. on Oct. 25, 2019, beginning at 7 a.m.

The building has been deemed hazardous and the demolition is being carried out by order of the Planning Advisory Committee, under *Section XV of the Municipal Government Act*, in order to ensure the safety of its citizens.

The town has pursued all legal options to remedy the situation prior to ordering the building's demolition and obtained all necessary permits to carry it out.

There will be no street closures as a result of this demolition. However, people in the area advised to use caution as heavy machinery will be used to demolish the building and trucks carrying debris will be using Industrial Park Drive to enter and exit the property.
