RE: Town of Amherst to demolish 23 Spring St.

AMHERST, Nova Scotia – The Town of Amherst will be demolishing a building at 23 Spring St. on Oct. 28, 2019, beginning at 7 a.m.

The demolition, which is expected to take two days, is being carried out because the building has been deemed unsightly, unsafe and a hazard to the safety of the general public.

The town has pursued all legal options to remedy the situation prior to ordering the building's demolition and obtained all necessary permits to carry it out.

People in the area of the demolition are advised to use caution as heavy machinery will be used to demolish the building.

Spring Street, between Albion and Croft streets, will be closed to through traffic during the demolition, but will be open for local traffic only.

The detour around the demolition site will be Albion Street to Queen Street to Croft Street to Spring Street and Albion Street to Croft Street to Spring Street.



The sidewalk in front of 23 Spring St. will be closed during the demolition.
