Access Awareness Week, recognized across the country as National Accessibility Week, an annual celebration that takes place during the last week of May to raise awareness about disability, access and inclusion.



The provincial theme this year is "Our Voices, Our Votes: Disability Rights in Action" and it takes place from May 25 to May 31. Nova Scotia's disability community was the first in the country to champion Access Awareness Week as an extension of Rick Hansen's 1987 Man in Motion world tour. For 38 years, Nova Scotians have organized community events, flag raisings, forums, and awards during Access Awareness Week to celebrate accessibility work and bring attention to the lived experiences of people with disabilities.

The Town of Amherst will hold a flag raising and proclamation on Monday May 26th at 9am at the YMCA flagpole.
